The Centre and its partners assist individuals to succeed on the Nigerian job market and support those who are looking for education, training or options to set up a business.

In the areas of jobs, migration and reintegration, the Centre works in partnership with the Nigerian Federal Ministry of Labour and Employment (FMLE) and its Migrant Resource Centres.

The NGC also provides advice on the requirements for regular migration.

We offer a wide range of support measures:

If you are looking for training and career opportunities in Nigeria:

- Information and advice on educational opportunities, career guidance and labour market perspectives
- Referrals to targeted vocational skills development and entrepreneurial trainings
- Support for active job seekers on CV writing, job applications and interviews
- Employability and occupational guidance trainings
- Job fairs to link job seekers with prospective employers
- Support for entrepreneurship and business start-up activities
- Referrals to potential employers and placement into jobs and internships

If you are returning to Nigeria from abroad, we provide:

- Information and referral to reintegration support programmes for returning migrants
- Tailored advice – no matter if you are still abroad or already in Nigeria, the advisory centre benefits everyone
- Referrals to psychosocial support and shelter services
- Contacts in departments, institutions and other advisory services of non-governmental organizations
