The German Centres for Jobs, Migration and Reintegration (GMAC) in Iraq support the economic, social, and psychological reintegration of returnees and provide information and advice on employment, training opportunities, business start-ups and business development in Iraq. The support is available for returnees who need assistance in their reintegration, for the members of the local population as well as the Internally Displaced Persons (IDP)s and refugees. The GMACs and its partners work to assist those who are seeking to improve their career chances and develop their skills.

In addition, to support returnees in their reintegration, the Centres provide advice on education and health in Iraq. The GMACs and its partners also provide legal, health and Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS). The Centres work in partnership with several international and local organizations and in close cooperation with the related governmental institutions.

The GMAC in the Kurdistan Region of Iraq and the GMAC in Baghdad consecutively were opened in 2018 and 2019.

- Advice on business development
- Job fairs to link between job seekers and employers
- Connection between institutions and people who are willing to do internships or voluntary work
