In the areas of jobs, migration and reintegration, the Centre works in partnership with the Ministry of Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development (MOPHRD) and Overseas Pakistanis Foundation (OPF).

The PGFRC also provides advice on the requirements for regular migration.

We offer you a wide range of support...

If you are looking for training and career opportunities in Pakistan:

- Information and advice on educational opportunities, career guidance and labour market perspectives
- Referrals to targeted vocational skills development and entrepreneurial training, e.g. digital employability skills
- Help for active job seekers on CV writing and how to apply for a job
- Technical and vocational skills trainings on domestic tailoring, embroidery, beauticians, mobile repairing, and more
- Support for business development training and business start-up activities
- Advice on getting microfinance and loans

If you are returning to Pakistan from abroad, we provide:

- Information and referral to reintegration support programmes for migrants who have returned to Pakistan
- Tailored advice – no matter if you are still abroad or already in Pakistan, everyone can receive advice
- Referrals to psychosocial support and information on the health system
- Contacts in departments, institutions and other advisory services of non-governmental organisations
